### WHY DO YOU DO WHAT YOU DO?

#### EXAMPLE FOR FINDING THE ROOT "WHY?" BEHIND WHAT YOU DO

Why do you brush your teeth? Probably because you don't want to get a cavity.

But why don't you want a cavity? Maybe because you don't want to go to the dentist.

Then why don't you want to go to the dentist? Perhaps because you don't like the dentist.

But why? Could be because you are afraid of what they will do.

Why are you afraid? Possibly because you don't trust God to protect you.

#### LETS TRY THIS ONE

Why do you consume social media? Because I'm bored.

Why are you bored? Because I don't want to do anything on my list.

Why? Because I don't feel like it.

Why? Because there doesn't seem to be any reason to do it. I have no motivation.

Why? Because I have no purpose. Nothing to wake up to that excites me.

#### YOUR TURN

Take something you do and trace it down to the root. When you can't answer another "Why?" you've gone as far as you can. That is the root reason for why you do whatever that thing is.
